



CLEANING, SAFETY, & PUBLIC HEALTH REGULATIONS

The year of 2020 the United States and world was impacted by the affects of a worldwide public health concern labeled, Novel Human Coronavirus. Due to the restrictions and regulations businesses were highly encouraged to follow cleanliness guidelines set forth by Philadelphia Mayoral Office and OSHA and FEMA agencies.

GILEAD routinely cleaned and disinfected frequently touched surfaces (e.g., doorknobs, light switches, countertops) with industrial cleaners (29 CFR 1910.141). GILEAD used all cleaning products according to the directions on the label. GILEAD practiced cleanly procedures for members/patrons: temperature checks, face mask verification (upon entry and exit), use of hand-sanitizers (including disinfecting wipes) upon entry (29 CFR 1910, 1910.133 1910.141, 1910.138).

GILEAD performed a hard cleaning of all soft, hard, (and air) surfaces three times a week. GILEAD mandated all members and patrons to complete a health-screening survey that was completed before entry was granted into any service or event (29 CFR 1904). A report of these surveys can be requested in writing by an official letter.
